The official University Computer Science Minor requires a total of 18 credits. The two required courses are CompSci 201 and CompSci 315. The remaining 12 credits are to be selected from the list of undergraduate computer science courses and must include at least 6 credits of CompSci courses at the 300 level or above.

The Minor in Computer Science can be completed as part of the first bachelor's degree at UWM or after completing a degree at UWM or another institution. A minimum of 12 credits of the minor must be completed at UWM. If the bachelor's degree was obtained at another institution, upon completion of the program the student will be awarded a Certificate of Minor.

One semester prior to the intended completion of the requirements for the minor, students must meet with an academic advisor in the College of Engineering and Applied Science to verify the requirements will be met with the planned courses. The minor will be recorded onto the student's transcript upon graduation.
